Promoter's Conditions

Meet Level

1. The Meet is licensed at Level 1, licence number 1LR0120, and shall be run under ASA laws, ASA Technical Rules and these promoter's conditions. The competition is open to swimmers who are at least 9 years old on 9 May 2010, and who are or have applied to be registered with the ASA as competitive Category 2 swimmers. Temporary members of the ASA will also be considered on the completion of the appropriate form and payment of the required fees (£15) to the Promoter for the same. Please contact the Promoter if you wish to apply for temporary ASA membership to enter this Meet.

Age Groups

2. The competition will be swum in the following age bands: 11/U, 12/13, 14/15, 16/0 (with age determined as at Midnight, 9 May 2010).

Pool

3. The competition will be held in an 8 lane, 50m pool with anti-wave lane ropes. Electronic timing and display will be in operation.

Events and Entries

4. Events are 50m and 200m all strokes; and 200m IM, for all age groups; and 100m all strokes, 400M IM, and 400m freestyle for girls who are at least 10 years old, and boys who are at least 11 years old.
5. Entries can be **submitted electronically (Sportsystems), details of which will be on our website from mid-February. Entries not submitted electronically will incur a charge of £5.00/competitor.** Entries will also be accepted on the official individual entry forms (with the appropriate surcharges).
6. Entries will be accepted up to and including the **closing date on Friday, 2 April 2010** (midnight). If the Meet is oversubscribed the Promoter reserves the right to restrict entries to the fastest/individual ages received whilst seeking to ensure that every age (not age group/band) is adequately represented in each event.

Fees and Payment

7. The entry fee is £6.00 per event.
8. Coach passes are £20.00 each for the weekend; daily passes are £12.50 each. The passes will entitle a holder to enter the Meet, a programme, refreshments, and a full set of results. Only swimmers and those displaying a coach pass will be allowed on poolside.
9. Payment for entries and coach passes must be made by a single cheque per club, to "Beckenham Swimming Club".
10. Spectator entry shall be by coded wrist bands, and shall be charged at £5.00 per session/£8.00 per day/£15 per weekend. Programmes shall be available at a cost of

£5.00 per programme/day. Children under the age of 10 shall gain entry free of charge.

The Competition

11. Over the Top Starts may be operated at the discretion of the Promoter (except for backstroke). The heats will be run all ages seeded together and the final heat of each event will be spearheaded. All events will be swum on a 'Heat Declared Winner' basis.

Awards and Trophies

12. The following shall apply:
- Medals will go to the top three places in each age group for each event.
 - There will be an award for the **Top Junior Girl and Boy**, and **Top Senior Girl and Boy** of the Meet – to be decided by the promoter at her sole discretion.
 - There will also be an award for the **Top Visiting Club**.

Data Protection

13. Meet entries will be managed on a computer. Your consent to the holding of personal information for the purposes of the Meet will be treated as being given by the submission of your entries, as will your consent for such to be published during and after the Meet.

Qualifying Times

14. There are Qualifying Times for this Meet. Submitted times **MUST** be equal to or faster than the Qualifying Times. **Please submit 25m pool times.**

Photography

15. Anyone wishing to take still or digital photography (including using mobile phones to do this), must in accordance with the ASA Child Protection guidelines, register themselves with the Promoter on entry to the Meet. Beckenham SC shall have its own photographer at the event, and by submitting your entries for the Meet, you are consenting to such photography taking place. Such photographs and other keepsakes of the day/weekend will be available for purchase on the day/weekend, and afterwards, through our website at www.BeckenhamSwimmingClub.com.

Administration of the Meet

16. There shall be four sessions (two each day). A card-less entry system shall be used. Swimmers must sign in at the relevant desk at least 45 minutes before the start of the session. Failure to sign in within the stipulated time shall cancel the swimmer's right to compete, and they will only be allowed to swim if there is a spare lane available.
17. Swimmers in the first event of each session **MUST** report to the clerks of the course at least 10 minutes before the start of the session, and others at least one event before the start of the event in which they are swimming. It is the swimmers' and their coaches' responsibility that they report to the clerks of the course on time.
18. Results will be available soon after the Meet and shall be accessible on www.BeckenhamSwimmingClub.com. A swim shop will be in operation.
19. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any spectator, coach or swimmer.
20. Conditions not covered in these competition rules will be dealt with in accordance with the laws of the sport and at the discretion of the promoter.
21. Entries should be made on (subject to condition '5' above) the Individual Entry Form, or on the supplied disk and Club Summary Entry Form and sent to the Meet Promoter:
