



BOROUGH JUVENILES 2010

The Junior swimmers of Edmonton Phoenix had a chance to shine on Saturday 18th September, 2010 when they competed in the Enfield Borough Juveniles at Southbury Road. This is a gala for 8 to 11 year old Enfield swimmers competing in 50m swims for all four strokes and a 100 IM race.

The star performers on the night were Meghan Byrne(9) who was joint top girl winning all 5 of her races and setting new age group club records in the 50 free (33.81s) and the 100 IM (1.26.69s), and Josh Kirlew(11) who won the top boy award with four first places and a second place in the 50 Breast.

There was a large turnout from the Phoenix Squads and there were many excellent swims with several swimmers showing excellent potential for the future.

In the 8 year girls Alice Comerford did exceptionally well with 2 firsts (Back and Free) and 2 seconds (fly and IM). Lucy Di also had a third place in the 50 Breast.

In the 9 year girls along with Meghan Byrne there were strong swims from Caitlin McCabe with one second place (Back) and three third places (Free, Breast, IM). Maya Kirlew had one second place (Fly) and one third place (Back). Lily Tiernan also had a third place in the Fly.

For the 10 year old girls Anna Ryan finished second in the 50 Backstroke.

There was some very competitive racing in the 11 year girls with several of the races being decided by only a few hundredths of a second between three very strong swimmers. Mia Hawkes did very well winning 2 races (Back and Free), one second place (IM) and two third places (Fly and Breast).

In the 8 year boys the hot shots were Reece Hitchings with three first place finishes (Fly, Breast, IM), William McLennaghan with 2 first places (Back, Free) and Aijobe Dudu-Orumens with 2 second places (Breast, Back) and one third place (Free)

In the 9 year boys Callum Dodds had one first place (Back), two second places (Fly, Free) and one third place (IM). Deniz Erensoy had one first place (Fly) and two second places (Breast, Back). Oskar Soulas had three third place finishes (Fly, Back, Free)

In the 10 year boys Andrew Camilo had three first place finishes (Back, Breast, IM) and one second place (Free). Lewis Hitchings won two races (Free, Fly) and had two

second places (Breast, IM). Ted Winfield had one second place (Fly) and two third places (Free, IM). Daniel Alexander was second in the Backstroke.

In the 11 year boys along with Josh Kirlew's excellent swims, Tom Newman had one first (Breast) and four second places (Fly, Back, Fly, and IM), finishing only a few hundredths behind Josh in the Free and IM. Ben Howe had three third place finishes (Back, Fly, IM) and James Whiting came third in the Backstroke.
